

FAMILY CHILD CARE PROVIDER LIST

The following providers have been approved to provide childcare in their military family housing unit. All providers have met the requirements of AFI 34-276. Providers are required to provide developmentally appropriate activities and serve meals according to USDA guidelines. You may also come by and visit us at Bldg. 1988, Arnold Drive, which is located directly behind the Child Development Center. Openings are subject to change. Providers must have all paperwork completed before they can provide childcare. The number of openings is listed under each age group and an X is in the box for care that is provided by each provider.

Each license is only good for 1 year. After that year the providers will be taken back to the FCC panel for renewal once all inspections and background checks have been re-accomplished. All Family Child Care providers must be in compliance with Air Force Instruction 34-276.

- The Air Force regulations state that prior to admission in a FCC home, the following requirements must be met by the parent:
- The parent must sign the AF Form 1181 authorizing medical treatment for your child.
- Immunizations must be current. Children are required to have the Hep B series, varicella zoster, Seasonal Flu and H1N1 vaccination. The provider must be given proof of immunizations.
- The parent must give the provider phone numbers where he/she can be reached in case of emergency and two other people (other than parents) as local emergency contacts.
- Be sure the emergency contacts are also authorized to sign your child out.
- AF Form 357 is required for all single and/or dual military parents.
- Choose your provider before care is needed to be sure all forms are filled out completely. The provider has the necessary forms available in her home.
